11. To conduct yoga activity under Physical and Health Education practicum.
12. To organize medical check up camp for student-teachers.
13. To donate the books of multiple copies to practicing schools and B.Ed. students.

14. To begin English speaking course for student-teachers in our collage.
15. To encourage faculty members to participate in various activities of the university.
16. To arrange university examination for student-teachers in our college.
17. To provide job opportunities for student-teachers through Placement Cell of the institution.

Out Comes :

1. Content test was organized to assess the entry level knowledge and skills of fresh entrants.
2. Computers, DVD, Models, Charts, etc. were purchased to fulfill the needs of the B.Ed. course.
3. The COE has organized a workshop on 'Shuddhalekhan' in Marathi language through a lecture by Shri. Dhavan G.S.
4. The college has organized 'Teaching Aid Preparation Workshop' through a lecture by Mr. R.G. Gele. Student-teachers were trained to prepare inexpensive teaching aids. He guided about three dimensional pictures, still pictures, motion pictures, charts, techniques, etc.
5. To update and improve the quality of Library Collection, old and outdated material was removed form the library.
6. Book exhibition was organized in the library. All the teachers and students participated in this exhibition. It benefits them a lot.
7. The COE has organized a workshop on preparation of Action Research on teaching, training, evaluation, etc.
8. Student-teachers were encouraged to participate in various co-curricular activities of career development.
9. The COE has invited eminent personalities to deliver lectures on various topics which help teachers and students to develop their personality and strive for excellence in their respective fields.

10. The college has conducted a workshop on preparation of socially useful productive works through Work Experience Practicum.
11. The COE has organized training on 'Yoga' for B.Ed. students.
12. The college has organized medical check up camp for student-teachers with the help of Rural Hospital, Tasgaon.
13. The COE has donated the books of multiple copies to practicing schools and student-teachers also.
14. The college has started English Speaking Course for student-teachers.
15. The faculty members were encouraged to participate in the various activities of the university such as paper setting, paper assessment, LIC, interview, youth festival, etc.
16. The college has provided job opportunities for student-teachers through placement cell.
17. The COE has arranged University Examination for student-teachers from academic year 2009-2010.

2. New Academic Program Initiated (UG & PG) :

Our academic programs are fixed as per the Education faculty rules of Shivaji University, Kolhapur. Hence, we have less scope to initiate new academic programs. We have conducted English Speaking Course even then, we have provided an opportunity to the student-teachers who have an interest to study Environment Education.

3. Innovation in Curricular Design and Construction :

As per innovation in curricular design is concerned, there is very little scope for innovation. It is because the curriculum is designed by the Board of Studies of Shivaji University, Kolhapur. Once it is approved by the University, colleges do not have any permission to change it. But our faculty members are always in touch with the Board members. They express their views and expectations regarding the Curricular design, sometimes formally and sometimes informally. Sometimes it happens that some topics from the recommended syllabi are deleted or sometimes added to it. For this Shivaji University or other colleges organize a few workshops on curricular design. Our teachers attend them and exchange their views.

Such issues regarding syllabi are discussed in the meetings in the beginning of the academic year. Some new ideas and views are discussed to make teaching learning effective and interesting.

The use of the CDs, TV and DVD played an effective role in the curricular transaction.

4. Inter-Disciplinary Program started :

We do not have any inter-disciplinary programs (courses). However a few lectures delivered by the experts were of inter-disciplinary nature.

5. Examination Reforms Implemented :

Efforts have been made to evaluate students' academic and practical performance from time to time. Evaluation was carried out in the form of Content test, practical evaluation, home assignments, tutorials, internal evaluation, Interview, physical efficiency test, etc. Internal examination was taken up in the month of March 2010. The assessment forms for teachers are printed by the college. They are given to the student-teachers. After filling them a kind of result sheet is prepared and handed over to the principal. The principal then discussed with the concerned teachers by giving some suggestions for their betterment.

25. Computerization of Administration and the Process of Admissions and Examination Result, Issue and Certificates :

a. Computerization of Administration -

At present, two computers are in operation in the office. One computer has internet connection. Also the computerization of office is in progress. In this process almost all the work of administration, notices, pay sheets, correspondence, roll calls, pay rolls, certificates,

and audited statements is done by computer. For this work the non-teaching staff is trained through MS-CIT examination.

b. Process of admissions –

The admissions to B.Ed. course are given by the Govt. of Maharashtra through the network of Maharashtra Knowledge Corporation Ltd. (MKCL). Government conducts Common Entrance Test (CET). Academic scores and CET scores are considered to finalize the admissions.

Actually the college has no active role to play in the admission process. The college has composed the committee to verify the documents of admitted candidates. I/C Principal Dr. D.B. Shinde has completed the process of Admissions with the help of administrative staff and faculty members.

c. Examination results –

As soon as the university examination result is declared, the college makes a specific arrangement to let the student know the individual results. As soon as the college is in receipt of mark lists, the student-teachers concerned are notified and the mark lists are handed over to them. The college stake holders gained highest achievements in university examination April 2010.

45 students scored first class in the examination whereas 29 students got second class.

26. Increase in the Infrastructural Facilities :

The college has purchased two computers and stationary for practical work. Tables and chairs have been repaired. Three fire extinguishers have been made available in the college premise.

27. Technology Up-gradation :

There are six computers in the college. The student-teachers and the staff utilize these computers for their works. The student teachers use computers for IT lessons.

28. Computer and Internet Access and Training to Teachers and Students :

There is an easy access of computer and internet to both student-teachers and faculty members. This facility is utilized by the teaching staff for their recent references while student also utilize for their IT lessons.

Our college has Student Aid fund. Financial aid is given to economically poor , needy, sincere and hard working students for their educational expenditure.
